Code of Practice

Members shall practice with integrity, responsibility and trustworthiness and shall recognise their responsibility to clients, clients dogs and other pets, clients property, and society in general. The welfare of clients dogs and other pets shall be paramount and shall not be made subordinate to commercial consideration. Members shall maintain professional relationships with their clients and shall not exploit such relationships for improper personal, professional or financial gain, nor seek inappropriately to impose their own values on clients. Members shall not disclose any personal or private information about their clients. Members shall not seek to attract business unfairly or unprofessionally or conduct their practice in any way which would discredit the reputation of the Association. Members are required to accept and abide by this code, to abide by and observe any other rules, regulations and pronouncements of the Association, and to acknowledge that membership shall not be used to endorse the activities of any club, society or other organisation. Members are not permitted to speak on behalf of the Association in their endorsement or commercialisation of any product, service or in the event of interview or provision of information to any member of the press or other media. Members must not make misleading claims or statements in advertising or otherwise. Members must abide by the Terms and Conditions (below) and by those of the Companies/Agencies for whom they undertake assignments.

Terms and Conditions for Registered Petsitters

Members must genuinely love animals and have experience of owning/caring for them. Members who offer to board dogs should not board dogs from more than one owner at a time. Members engaged in dog boarding, house/petsitting should not leave dogs/pets or property unattended except for very short periods, as agreed with owners, or in emergency (day visits are not acceptable if dogs are then to be left unattended at night). Members should: provide clean, dry, warm, draught-free bedding space; an area for dogs/pets to relieve themselves; food and exercise to owners requirements and maintain dogs/pets normal routine. Members should arrange to meet owners well in advance and ensure Petsitters Terms and Conditions and Forms of Authority are understood and signed by owners. (All forms are supplied as part of Registration package). Dog Walkers should not walk more than four dogs at any one time, and always on leads except when confined to a safe and secure area and with the owners permission. They must ensure proper control at all times and dispose of excrement safely. Members are required to obtain a valid police check certificate if they hold keys to, or have access to clients' property for the purpose of pet/house sitting, dog walking or other services. Members must keep proper records of all work undertaken. Members must show evidence of having knowledge of basic animal training, first aid, and general care for the pets for which they are responsible. In the case of exotic pets they should seek specific guidance from the owner about the care of such pets and ensure that the owner is satisfied as to their competence. Members must abide by all current Health and Safety legislation. Members must abide by all National and Local Laws and Byelaws. Members are responsible for their own businesses. They are under no obligation to board/care for dogs/pets/property if they choose not to. The National Association of Registered Petsitters/National Petsitters act only as Agents and cannot be held liable to or responsible for either party or their pets or property. Registration is renewable on payment of the annual membership fee. NARP reserves the right to visit any member and if necessary to inspect their premises to ensure that the Code of Practice and these Terms and Conditions are being adhered to. Registration may be cancelled for any breaches of the Code of Practice or these Terms and Conditions. In the event of cancellation, for any reason, the person concerned will have no rights to operate as a Registered Petsitter and to immediately return their Registration Certificate and all unused stationery. Failure to comply may result in prosecution. Membership fees are not refundable. The attention of Registered Petsitters is drawn to the terms of the Animal Boarding Establishments Act 1963. "National Petsitters LTD" is the Trading Name of NARP.

ON THE CONDITION THAT REGISTRATION REMAINS VALID AND REGISTRATION FEES HAVE BEEN PAID IN FULL, THE ABOVE MENTIONED PERSON IS COVERED FOR PRODUCTS/PUBLIC LIABILITY INSURANCE FOR LOSS AND/OR DAMAGE TO THIRD PARTY PROPERTY AND/OR BODILY INJURY TO THIRD PARTY PERSONS ARISING OUT OF HIS/HER ACTIVITIES AS A REGISTERED PETSITTER. COVER TO INCLUDE INJURY, DEATH, OR TREATMENT RISKS OF/TO CLIENT PET AS A RESULT OF NEGLIGENCE. TO THE LIMIT OF £1,000,000 ANY ONE ACCIDENT AND/OR A MAXIMUM OF £500 PER ANIMAL IN RESPECT OF INJURY, DEATH OR TREATMENT RISKS. INSURANCE PROVIDED BY THE ROYAL & SUNALLIANCE: POLICY NUMBER SL-RKKS12049. AN EXCESS OF £100 APPLIES IN EACH CASE. EXCLUSIONS ARE DANGEROUS ANIMALS AND POISONOUS SNAKES. IN THE EVENT OF ANY CLAIM MEMBERS MUST NOT INVITE OR ADMIT LIABILITY. ALL CLAIMS MUST BE MADE IN WRITING AND SENT DIRECTLY TO NATIONAL PETSITTERS. IMMEDIATE NOTICE MUST BE GIVEN OF ANY EVENT WHICH MAY LEAD TO A CLAIM.
